

Privacy Policy

IC-Health and the partner organisations delivering this project are committed to your privacy. This privacy policy sets out how we deal with personal information collected through <https://ichealth-moocs.eu/> - IC-Health MOOC platform (“the Platform” or “the Web Page”). By using the Platform you consent to the use and processing of your personal information in accordance with this privacy policy.

Like most web pages, there is certain information that is automatically tracked. This includes the web page you just came from if you followed a link to our platform, the browser you are using and any searches you have done to find one of our pages. The information is used for internal purposes to monitor activity on the Platform only. It is kept in a form that does not identify individuals.

Personal information you may share with us through this platform includes name and contact information in the event of you registering to our MOOCs. We have made efforts to collect the minimum information needed to respond to queries and requests.

Answers to the quizzes embedded to the MOOCs - after learning units and at the end of each MOOC - are collected by the IC-Health project and they will be exclusively used for scientific purposes. These results may be described in project deliverables and presented in scientific publications or conferences and may be used in further studies.

IC-Health will not share your personal information to any other organisation or to other projects without first obtaining your consent. Personal information will be anonymised, so that it is impossible to trace this information back to you individually. We shall keep your personal information for the duration of the project and up to a year after its end to ensure the sustainability of the project even after its completion.

Although we have rigorous technical and organisational security procedures in place to keep your information secure, including use of an SSL certificate and strong passwords, you are advised to remember that the internet is not always a secure medium.
